Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The City of Corning is updating its Housing Element, a State-mandated policy document that is part of the City's General Plan. The purpose of the Housing Element Update is to assess current and projected housing needs, identify suitable locations for housing development, and establish goals, policies, and programs to address the community's housing needs. Central to the Housing Element is the Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA), which is 186 housing units. The City has identified sufficient sites with the capacity to accommodate 271 units beyond the RHNA requirement.
