PUBLIC CODE OF CONDUCT

Adopted by the Board of Supervisors September 16th, 2025

- 1.) Treat all participants with kindness and respect, valuing the diverse opinions and views.
- 2.) Listening is an important sign of respect.
- 3.) Comments should be clear and brief and stay on topic.
- 4.) Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior.
- 5.) Avoid distracting behaviors such as private conversations and phone use.
- Exercise self-control. No threats of violence and loud or offensive communications.
- 7.) Understand the rights of individuals to speak at public meetings including the right to criticize the government.

Violations of this Code may result in removal from the meeting.
