The Planning Commission is a body of five (5) residents. Each Member of the Board of Supervisors shall nominate one member of the planning commission, subject to confirmation by the full Board of Supervisors. The Planning Commission meets on a bi-monthly basis, on the First and Third Thursday of each month at 9:00 a.m., with special meetings as needed. The Planning Commission is an advisory board to the Board of Supervisors along with serving as a planning body that makes land use decisions. The Planning Commission also reviews and makes recommendations on the community's General Plan. Major areas of involvement are real estate development projects and business uses.
