NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING
VERIFIED ARGUMENTS ON MEASURES**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Measures: Measure S, is to be voted on at the Statewide Primary Election to be held in the City of Red Bluff, on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. The following measure will be submitted to the electorate of the City of Red Bluff:

MEASURE S

Street Safety, Maintenance, and Road Tax Citizen Initiative. Shall the measure providing Red Bluff funding to fix potholes; maintain and repair deteriorating local streets and roads; reduce expensive future repairs; improve safety for drivers, pedestrians, disabled residents, including safe routes to children's school; and make the City eligible for state/ federal matching funds, by establishing a locally controlled 1-cent sales tax providing approximately \$5,100,000 annually for 12-years; requiring independent audits and public disclosure, be adopted?

Verified Arguments for and against these measures may be submitted to the Tehama County Elections Office at 633 Washington St, Room 17, Red Bluff not later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, March 13, 2026 which has been determined by the County Clerk under the authority of California Elections Code Sections 9163 to be a reasonable date based on the time necessary to prepare and submit the arguments. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length.

Pursuant to Section 9287 of the California Elections Code, one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters in the voter pamphlet. Preference and priority in selection will be given to arguments as follows:

1. The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body;
2. The individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measure;
3. Bona fide associations of citizens;
4. Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure.
