REFUND POLICY

Refunds may be made for any fee erroneously paid or collected. Refunds may be made for services not rendered. All refunds shall be less departmental costs (e.g. filing fee, plan review, inspections, ect.), minimum \$45.00. No refunds for permit renewal applications or annual fees.

Claims for refunds shall be by written request by the person who paid the fee and must be made within one year of date period.

Annual program fees may be prorated quarterly.

FEE CATEGORY

When no appropriate Fee Category exists for a requested service, that service shall be provided at the current Departmental Hourly Rate. A minimum fee of one hour shall be required prior to commencing work on the application for service. Time shall be tracked and rounded to the next nearest 15 minutes for billing purposes. Upon completion or within 90 days, an Invoice for the cost of services provided or a refund of any unused portion shall be sent to the applicant. These fees shall be due and payable within 30 days from the Invoice date.

DELINQUENT FEES

These fees shall be paid to the Department of Environmental Health within 30 days after the date of billing. Any fees not paid within such 30 day period shall be subject to a late fee in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the
