Argument in Favor of Measure G
Los Molinos Unified School District

Our schools are some of the most important assets in our community and should be our number one priority. Quality schools improve student achievement, increase property values, prepare children for a productive future, and create greater neighborhood safety. Although our teachers and staff do a great job educating local students, many classrooms and school facilities in the Los Molinos Unified School District are outdated and inadequate to provide students with the school facilities they need to succeed.

While our schools have been well maintained over the years, they are old. The average age is 76 years, and Vina Elementary School, our oldest, was first built in 1924! Aging classrooms and facilities must be upgraded, since many do not meet 21st-century educational, safety, or technological standards. Measure G would allow the District to improve our neighborhood schools and the quality of education provided to local students.

Measure G will provide funding to make critical facility improvements at Los Molinos schools including:

- Improving career technical education programs
- Making safety and security improvements
- Replacing deteriorating plumbing and sewer systems
- Constructing a new elementary gymnasium and upgrading high school athletic facilities for school and community use
- Constructing new classrooms to replace temporary portable classrooms

Measure G makes financial sense and protects taxpayers.

- By law, spending must be reviewed and annually audited by an independent citizens' oversight committee.
- All bond funds must be spent locally and **cannot be taken by the State.**
- Funds are required to be spent only on schools not for administrator or teacher salaries.
- Qualifies the District for \$8 million in State matching funds to help pay for improvements
