Combined Signature Verification and Unsigned Envelope Statement & Instructions

VOTER ACTION REQUIRED

Failure to follow the instructions may cause your Vote by Mail Ballot not to count.

Our office received your Vote By Mail (VBM) ballot, but **the envelope is either unsigned or the signature provided does not match the signature(s) on file in your voter record**. Your signature attesting to your eligibility is required by law. To ensure that your ballot will be counted, the below Statement must be signed next to "VOTER SIGNATURE X," completed, and returned as soon as possible. The signature provided on the completed Statement may be added to your registration record to be used for signature comparison purposes in future elections. I am a resident of the precinct in which I have voted, and I am the person whose name appears on the Vote by Mail ballot envelope. I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. I understand that my failure to sign this statement means my Vote by Mail ballot will be invalidated. I further declare that I have not and will not vote more than one ballot in this election.
